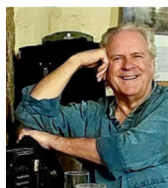

guitar. Music inspired by many cultures.

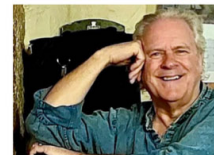
BAKLAVA
